
### Step 3. Measuring your Space

If the current layout is not changing, measure the current countertop. These dimensions are not meant to be One Hundred percent accurate. We recommend measuring each area twice to ensure the most accurate dimension.

- 1. Note on the drawing where all door openings and windows are located. Measure these areas from outer casings or door trims.
- 2. Measure to locate the centers of your sink and appliances.
- 3. Indicate on the drawings where there are electrical elements, I.e: Light switches and/or plugs

If you are replacing your cabinetry not through Heffner Cabinetry & Stoneworks. Please ask the company you are working with for a floor plan for us to reference.
